**LESSON #28****EXODUS 21-23**

Chapters 21-23 tell us of the different laws that God gave to Moses up on the Mount in order to have a moral, just and orderly society. Ex. 21:1-6 is about the bondservant. We read in other verses that anyone who murdered another was to be put to death, and we also read (vs. 17) that "...he that curseth his father, or his mother, shall surely be put to death." In Chapter 22 we read that the people were to kill anyone who was a witch, and those who sacrificed to any other god were to meet the same fate.

**LESSON #32****EXODUS 32:15-35**

Today we see artists' drawings of the tablets with the Ten Commandments written on them, so when we read about them in the Bible, we assume that is what they looked like. However, archaeologists have discovered many ancient clay "tablets" with inscriptions engraved on them, and they are quite small, about the size of a baseball. The tablets that God wrote on which Moses carried down the mountain "in his hand" were probably much smaller than we picture them.
